Local Rules

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1)

- a) Beyond this line of white stakes to the right of first hole and behind the second green.
- b) Beyond the rabbit fence to the right of the second hole.
- c) Beyond the line of white stakes to the left of the third fairway.
- d) Beyond the rabbit fence running from short of the fourth green to the back of the ninth tee, bounding the sixth and seventh holes on the right and running at the back of fifth and eight greens.

2. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

3. PROTECTION OF TREES AND SHRUBS

If any young trees or shrubs, marked by stakes, interfere with a player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i) (Immovable Obstruction).

4. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of putting green at the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows:

- If the ball lies off the putting green but not in hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which:
 - a) is not nearer the hole,
 - b) avoids such intervention and
 - c) is not in hazard or on a putting green.

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1b)

Relief MUST be taken from any area defined as Ground Under Repair.

6. INTEGRAL PARTS THE COURSE (Rule 28)

All stone walls and perimeter fencing are integral parts of the course. The ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable.

7. PATHS

All paths with artificial surfaces are immovable obstructions and, therefore, relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2.

8. CALL ON HOLES

Holes four and nine are both call on holes competitions (details are posted on the notice boards in the Clubhouse).

9. LOCAL RULE

All wooden fencing within the golf course, excluding boundary fences and sponsors materials on the course, are immovable obstructions, and relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2b.

(The player shall lift the ball and drop it within one club-length of and not nearer the hole than the nearest point of relief, on a part of the course which avoids interference by the immovable obstructions and is not in a hazard or on a putting green).

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:

Stroke Play – Two Strokes;
Match Play – Loss of Hole.
